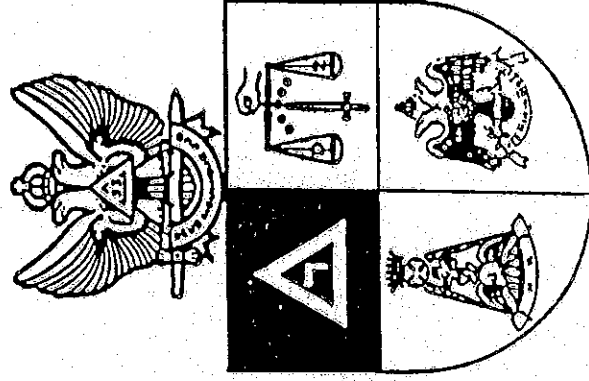
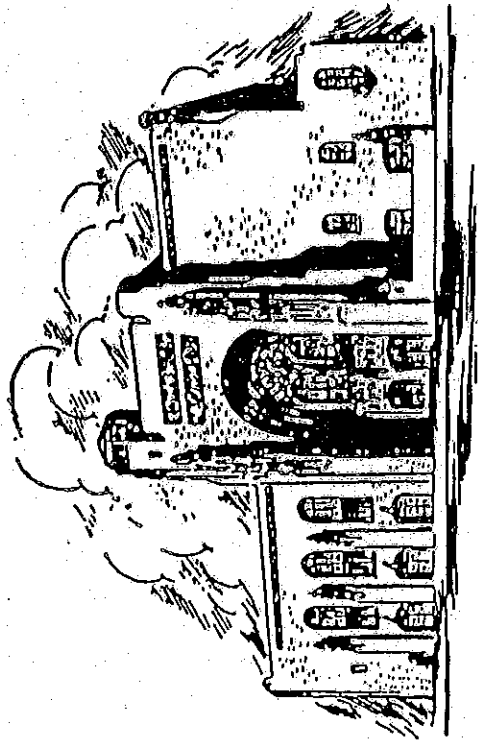

DECLARATION OF PRINCIPLES

BY THE

Supreme Council of Sovereign Grand Inspectors General
Ancient Accepted Scottish Rite of Freemasonry
For the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction of the
United States of America

This Supreme Council reaffirms its unswerving loyalty to the fundamental purpose of Freemasonry, which purpose from time immemorial has been to improve and strengthen the character of the individual man, and through the individual, the character of the community, thus undergirding the community with those spiritual values which give it strength and stability.

This Supreme Council believes that this purpose is to be attained by laying a broad basis of principle upon which men of every race, country, sect and opinion may unite. Believing that good and true men can be trusted to act well and wisely, this Supreme Council considers it the duty of the Fraternity to impress upon its members the principles of personal righteousness and personal responsibility, to enlighten them as to those things which make for human welfare, and to inspire them with that feeling of charity, or well-wishing, toward all mankind which will move them to translate principle and conviction into action.

To that end Freemasonry teaches a belief in God and faith in His divine purposes. It encourages the worship of God in conformity with the dictates of individual conscience. It stands for truth and justice, liberty and enlightenment, fraternity and philanthropy.

This Supreme Council expects of its members strict obedience to the laws of the land, and respect for their country's flag.

Such principles unite men and encourage the pursuit by them individually and collectively of worthy endeavors and the attainment of the purposes inherent in them. In that unity human character achieves its highest unfolding and provides man's best hope for peace on earth and good will among men.

To the furtherance of these principles, all our ritual is directed and all our efforts are aimed. To their furtherance each Master Mason has pledged himself, and at the portal of the Scottish Rite has renewed that pledge.

This Supreme Council discourages and rejects any attempt by any international groups or confederations of Scottish Rite Supreme Councils to legislate for individual Supreme Councils.

Recognizing that principles unite men, that programs sometimes divide them, and that the preservation of unity of purpose and devotion to principle is essential to Freemasonry, the Supreme Council affirms its continued adherence to that ancient and approved rule of Freemasonry which forbids the discussion within tiled doors of creeds, politics, or other topics apt to excite personal animosities.

This Supreme Council further affirms its conviction that it is not only contrary to the fundamental principles of Freemasonry, but exceedingly dangerous to its unity, strength, usefulness and welfare for Masonic Bodies in their official capacity to take formal action or attempt to exercise pressure or influence for or against any particular legislative project or proposal, or in any way to attempt to procure the election or appointment of Governmental officials, whether executive, legislative or judicial, or to influence them, whether or not members of the Fraternity, in the performance of their official duties.

Thomas Wright, 32°, CLD

Bro. Wright is a native of Hamilton, Scotland. He came to the United States some 61 years ago and resides in Dickson City. He attended Dickson City schools, and graduated from Dickson City High School. He entered the U. S. Army, where he served in the European Theater of Operations (1943-45). Bro. Tommy retired from Superior Fireproof Door and Sash Company, Scranton, in 1989, where he was employed for 41 years. He became a Mason in 1957 in Kingsbury Lodge #466, in Olyphant, Pa. He was Worshipful Master in 1969, served as Treasurer for some years, and now is Tyler in three different Lodges: King Solomon Lodge #584, Peter Williamson Lodge #323, and, his Lodge, Kingsbury #466. He is, presently, serving on the Board of Directors of the Memorial Hall Association, in Olyphant. He, also, joined the Top Hatters Club of Northeastern Pennsylvania. He became a member of the Valley of Scranton Scottish Rite Bodies in November 1962 and became very active. Bro. Tommy has served on the Planning Committee and the Membership Committee. He is, now, a Tyler for the Valley, has taken parts in degree work in the Valley, and portrays parts in the plays "December's Rose" and "Judge Not." Bro. Tommy was awarded the C.L.D. (Citation for Loyalty and Dedication) in May 1984.

Bro. Wright is a member of the First Primitive Methodist Church, in Dickson City, and has served as an usher and, also, as an officer of the Board of Trustees.

He has been married to the former Ethyl Dolph of Dickson City for 43 years.

The Valley of Scranton and its Officers wish Bro. Wright success and the hope that all he has done for the Masonic Fraternity will not be forgotten.

III IRA B. COLDREN, JR. 33°

Active for Pennsylvania

III Ira Coldren, Jr., 33° was educated in the public schools of Uniontown, Pa. He attended Penn State University and graduated from the United States Military Academy in 1945.

III Coldren served in the U.S. Army for 11 years. His assignments included Germany and Austria, Fort Riley, the Pentagon, Korea, and the Judge Advocate General's School in Charlottesville, Virginia. During his service, he attended the University of Pennsylvania Law School, from which he graduated in 1952.

He resigned from the regular Army in 1956 as a Captain. He subsequently served in the Army Reserves and retired in 1968 as a Lieutenant Colonel.

Following his active military service, III Brother Coldren returned to Uniontown, Pa. and entered the private practice of law in his father's firm. After a few years, his father and he formed a new law firm, which is now known as Coldren, Adams, DeHaas & Radcliffe, and includes nine lawyers.

III Brother Coldren married Frances Thomas Whyel on August 27, 1971. By a prior marriage he has four children. He has nine grandchildren.

He served on the Board of Governors of the Pennsylvania Bar Association from 1982 and was President of the Association in 1986-87. He, also, served as President of the Pennsylvania Bar Institute in 1982-83. A past member of the House of Delegates of the American Bar Association, he is, also, a fellow of the American Bar Foundation and the American College of Trust and Estate Counsel, as well as a member of the International Association of Defense Counsel, the American Judicature Society and the American Law Institute.

III Brother Coldren was raised a Master Mason in Fayette Lodge No. 228, F. & A.M., Uniontown, November 27, 1950, where he served as Master in 1964. He was Thrice Potent Master of the Uniontown Lodge of Perfection in 1969-70. He received his further Scottish Rite degrees in the Valley of Pittsburgh.

III Brother Coldren was created a Sovereign Grand Inspector General, 33°, Honorary Member of the Supreme Council in Cleveland, Ohio, in 1980, and was crowned an Active Member in Indianapolis, Indiana, on September 25, 1991.
